The Division of Vascular Surgery is looking for a dynamic, team-oriented Vascular Surgeon to help continue to build a comprehensive, fully integrated endovascular program to serve one of the largest patient populations with peripheral vascular disease in Canada. The successful candidate must have advanced endovascular experience and be able to provide the full spectrum of vascular care including EVAR, open aneurysm repair, carotid interventions, diagnostic angiography and endovascular interventions, dialysis access surgery, non-invasive vascular assessment and treatments for venous disease.

Osler is currently working towards building a state-of-the-art Hybrid Operating Suite with full access to endovascular and hybrid technologies scheduled for completion in early 2018.

The successful candidate must be able to be licensed to practice in Ontario and have Certification in Vascular Surgery from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Furthermore, an RPVI vascular diagnostic imaging certification is required. Application deadline will be April 21st and, the successful applicant will have a tentative start date of July 1, 2017.
